

# 2018 Duvall Art & Wine Walk Call for Artists

Of acceptance no later than August 24<sup>th</sup>.

The 2018 Duvall Art & Wine Walk, presented by The Duvall Art & Wine Walk Committee, is seeking artists to participate. This juried event aims to showcase professional artists of the Snoqualmie Valley along with regional artists of note. Duvall is one of five small towns in the beautiful Snoqualmie Valley, a rural area, 25 miles from Seattle, which combines the best of rural living with easy access to Seattle's cultural and technological core.

**What is the Duvall Art Walk?** A public art and wine tasting event promoting the culture and creativity of Duvall and our surrounding area. Local businesses throughout downtown Duvall open their doors to wineries and artists for the public to view and purchase art and wine. The art may be purchased from the artist with the business receiving a 20% commission. Some venues offer refreshments, and DCC provides music at appropriate locations throughout the event. This one day, regionally advertised, mapped, wine tasting and art walk, promotes the arts and highlights our vibrant valley! Since it began in 2010, this event has steadily grown and continues to attract talent and interest. Attendance at the 2017 Art Walk was over 500.

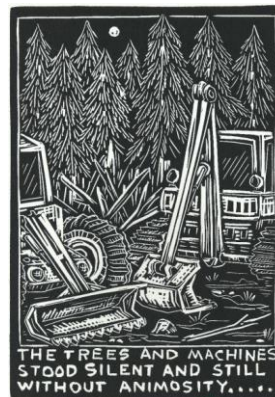

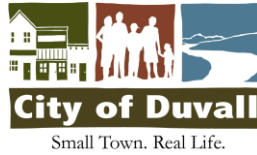


2017 Winner, Brandy M Agun
